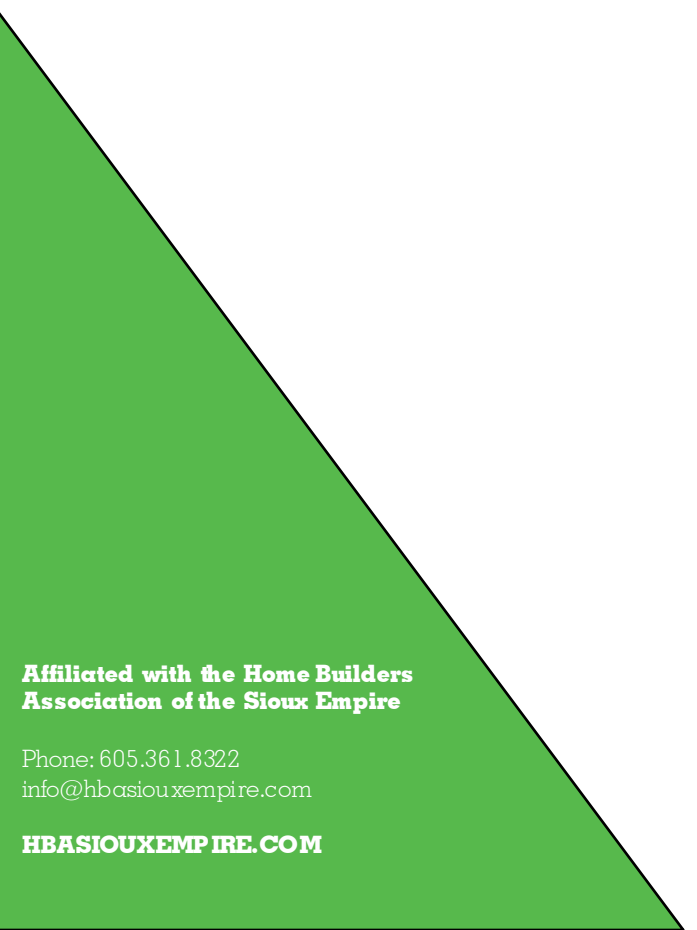
Repair Affair

❖ Repair Affair ❖

- Repair Affair is a one day event that allows volunteers from the Home Builders Association of the Sioux Empire the chance to help someone in need. Accessibility and safety related repairs are done on homes throughout the area.
- The focus of Repair Affair is on adapting the home for the elderly and/or permanently disabled.
- Projects done in the past include wheelchair ramps, hand rails, grab bars, threshold ramps and raised toilets.
- Since 1993, approximately 4,500 volunteer hours have been put towards completing over 140 projects.
- Qualified homeowners must apply for the free repairs.



❖ Tools for Schools ❖

- Tools for Schools is a program created to help schools throughout the Sioux Empire improve their construction curriculum.
- Since 2006, Tools for Schools has donated over \$32,000 in tools to local schools.
- The donated tools are necessary for students to learn hands on craftsmanship in the building industry.
- This program was developed to help further the educational opportunities in the area and provide them more knowledge in the construction industry.
- Schools in Lincoln, McCook, Minnehaha and Turner counties are encouraged to apply for tools.



❖ Scholarships ❖

- Scholarships are awarded annually to graduating high school seniors and also to those currently attending a college, university or technical college.
- Since 1990, over \$150,000 has been awarded to over 275 students.
- Scholarships benefit students who have applied for acceptance or are currently attending an accredited school and major in a construction-related field.
- Scholarship recipients must reside in Lincoln, McCook, Minnehaha or Turner county.
- Scholarship recipients are recognized annually at an HBASE General Membership Meeting.
