- Various HBASE businesses help sponsor the event, providing items such as food, water, t-shirts and more. The event is fun and allows members from the HBASE to work together for a great cause.



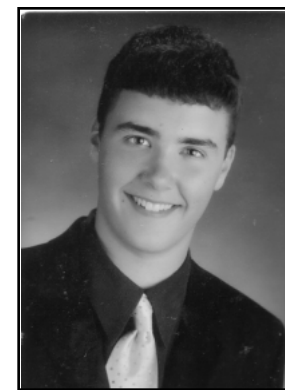
Tools for Schools
